CAFOD: Did you know...life was a daily struggle for Mulenga, who lives in Zambia, and has physical, mental and communication disabilities? His only means of getting about was either to roll his body where he needed to go or for someone to carry him. With CAFOD's support, Mulenga has become mobile through the use of a wheelchair and has trained as a farmer. He now employs other workers. Although severely disabled, Mulenga attracts the attention of others around and they listen to what he has to say. Just as Jesus' face was shining like the sun, Mulenga's light shines in Chushi village.
