In the Gospel story related to us today, we have the skeletal outline of the Mass. Walking from Jerusalem to Emmaus with the two disciples, Jesus opens up the Scriptures for them. (the Liturgy of the Word) and then breaks the bread (The Liturgy of the Eucharist). By those two actions the disciples recognised Jesus and are empowered to proclaim his resurrection.

In our celebration of the Mass, we should pray for the grace to encounter Jesus and to make him known.
