## OUR LADY OF EDEN PARISH PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

**9<sup>th</sup> April 2017**



Today we enter what is often referred to as, 'The Great Week.' All the central events of our salvation are played out this week. Palm Sunday recalls the fickleness of people; at one time crying; 'hosanna' and at another 'crucify him.' The Easter Triduum celebrates one event over three days. Maundy Thursday recalls the institution of the Priesthood and of the Mass, and linking both 'service' by the washing of the feet. Good Friday we recall the price paid, the lengths God went to, to reconcile us to himself. And then the great feast of Easter beginning with the Vigil – where the elements of fire, light and water are blessed. All is made new for Christ risen. We should be at all these Services for they are one event.
