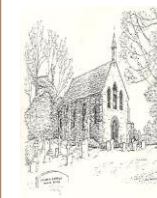

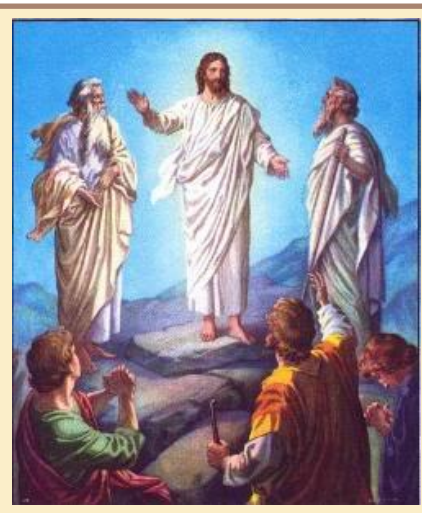


**OUR LADY OF EDEN PARISH**
