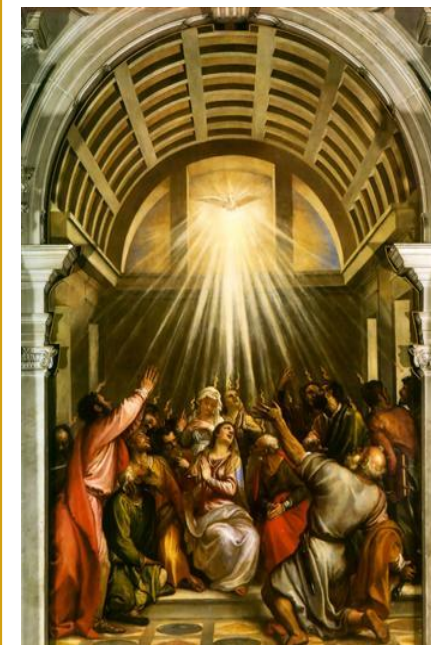

Further to this is the intention to widen the entrance off the A69.
